Upon determining the classification and all the potential contributing factors, Physical Therapists will be able to administer the most effective treatment / management options including mobilizations, manipulation, muscular control retraining and taping techniques.

INSTRUCTOR:

Dr. Bahram Jam graduated from the University of Toronto, Canada in 1992 with a Bachelors of Science in Physical Therapy. In 1999 he completed a clinical masters program at the University of Queensland, Australia receiving a Masters in Manipulative Physiotherapy Studies degree. In 2009 he completed his Doctorate in Science on Physical Therapy at Andrews University, USA. He has the Canadian Diploma of Advanced Manual and Manipulative Physiotherapy and is also accredited with the McKenzie Institute International.

He is the founder and director of Advanced Physical Therapy Education Institute (APTEI) and has been a chief instructor for over three hundred post-graduate Physical Therapy clinical courses across Canada and United Kingdom.

He is presently practicing at Athlete's Care Clinic Located at York University Campus, Toronto, Ontario, CANADA.
